Thank to those of you who have supervised your children completing and uploading the school work this week. We understand that this is not an easy option for many of us. Home learning and distance teaching is a challenge for all! Please be assured that we are here for you if you are experiencing any difficulties with the technology or the work itself.

Please note that we are unable to print work out. Teachers are working from home. The work does <u>not</u> need to be printed. We have provided every child with a book to complete work in. We have also loaned out IT equipment to the most needy families.

As I wrote yesterday, it is important that <u>all</u> children engage with the online learning. We need to do our very best to ensure that our youngsters do not fall behind in their learning. I have asked teachers to **call any parents of pupils** who do not upload work to SeeSaw and to keep me informed.

We will be open for educational support for our most vulnerable pupils and for children of keyworkers. From Wednesday 6th January—Friday 15th January, the school will be open from **8.45am—3.45pm** for the applications that have been accepted. We will offer breakfast for any pupils who come to school during this time. Please could all children bring refreshments and lunch to last them for the whole time they are in the HUB.
