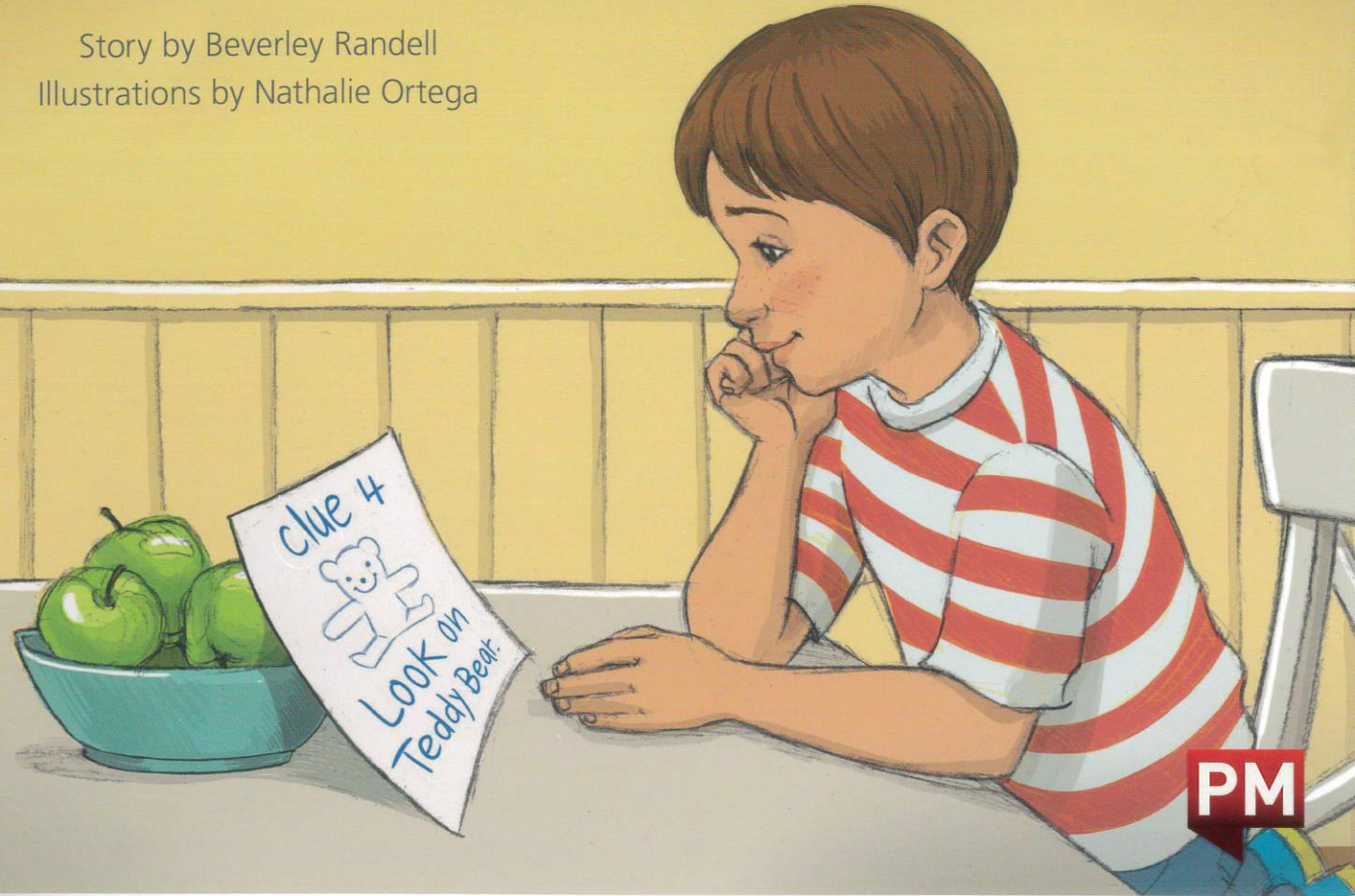

Key Teaching Points

Read the book title. Talk about treasure hunts. Predict what Ben may find.

Encourage students to take risks in their attempts at new vocabulary.

Key Questions

When Ben read clue 4, where did he have to look next? (*Literal*)

At the end of the story, why did Ben say, "I love you, Mum."? (*Inferential*)

Word Study

Use PM Alphabet Blends books *cl, pl* and *sw* to reinforce the initial letters in *clue, plane* and *swing*.

Reinforce the use of the initial letter as entry to each new word, e.g. *table, television, Teddy, treasure*.

Explain briefly the reason for the apostrophe in *Ben's Treasure Hunt* and *Mum's pocket*.

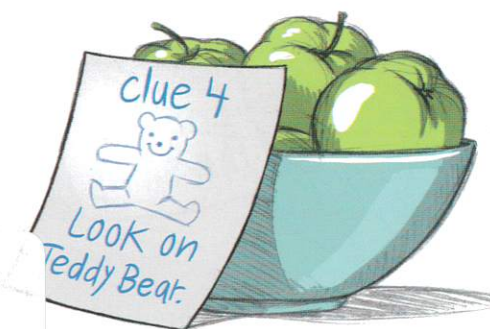
