BEFORE READING

Talk together

- Read the title together and find Chip's new trainers in the picture. Notice what the other children are wearing.
- Talk about your child's shoes. Ask: *Which pair do you like the best?*
- Look through the book and talk about the pictures.

About the words in this book

- Your child should be able to sound out and blend some words, which may include:

this got wet Dad

- Some words may be more challenging. Encourage or model blending, then read the words below to your child if necessary.

trainers liked
pair wore went
play muddy cross
washed oh**



DURING READING

Enjoy the story together. If your child needs support to read the words:

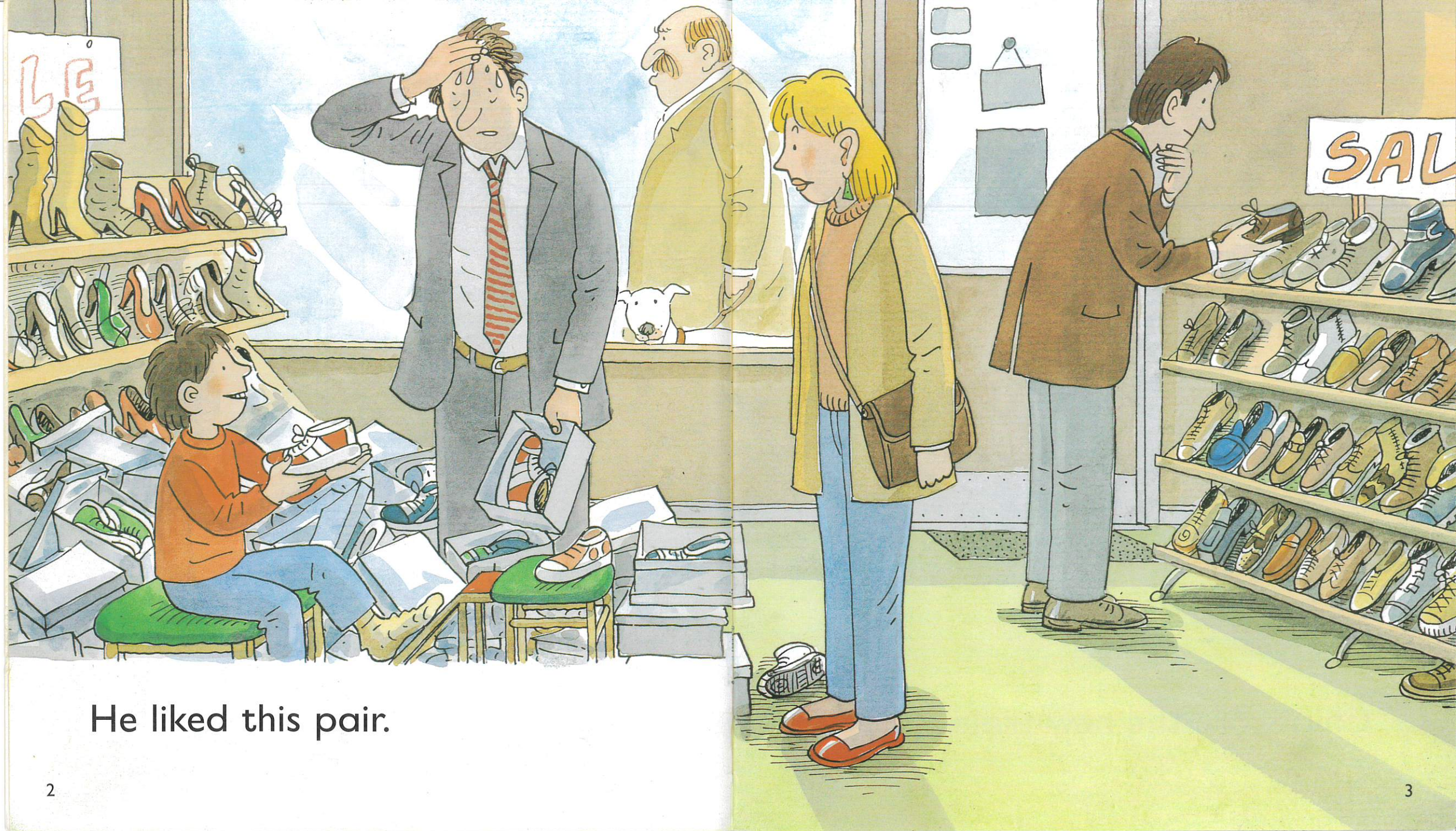
- Ask your child to point from left to right under each word whilst reading.
- Model how to sound out and blend new words if necessary.
- If a word is still too tricky, simply say the whole word for your child.
- Use the pictures to talk about the story and learn the meaning of new words.



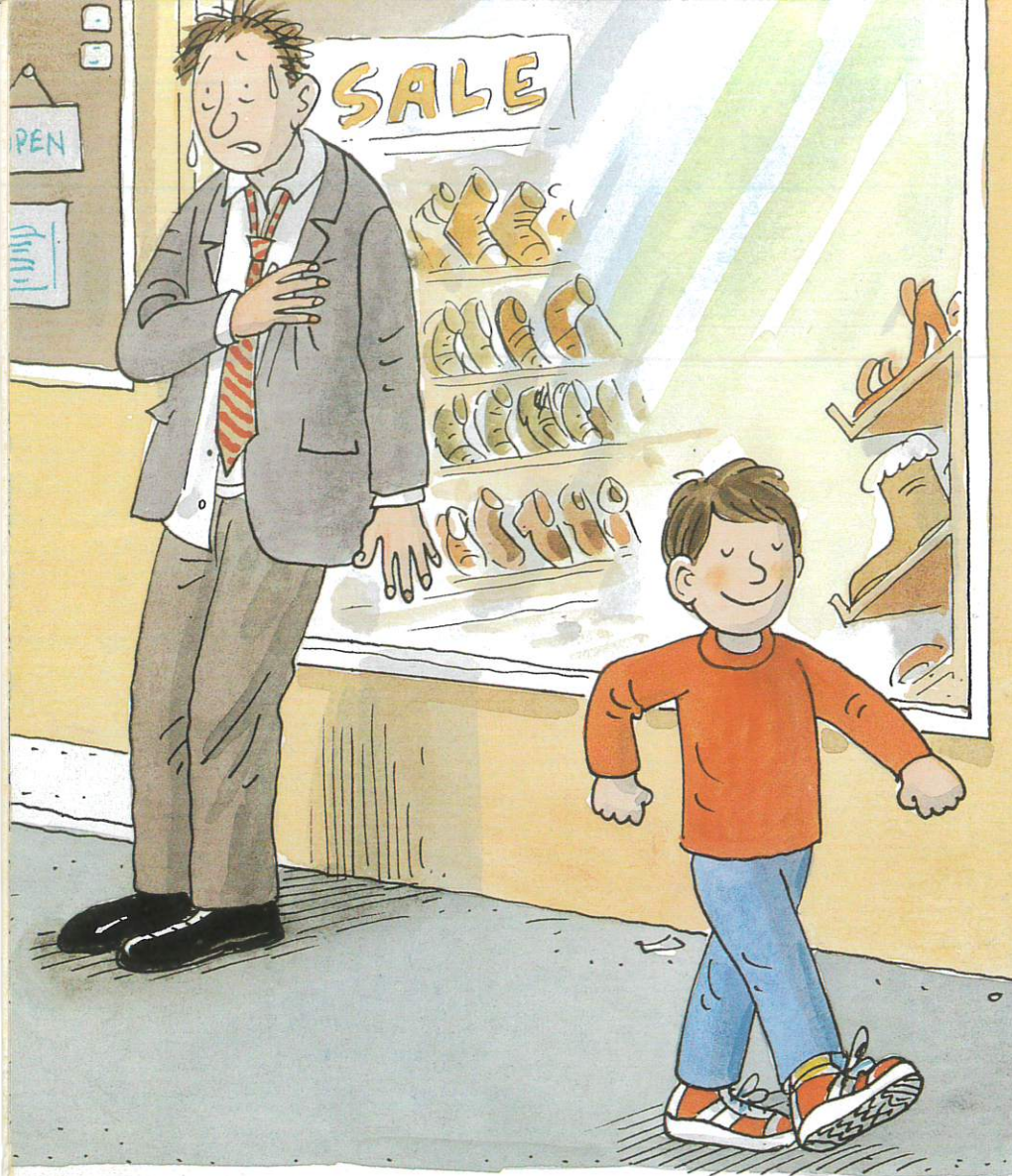

He liked this pair.

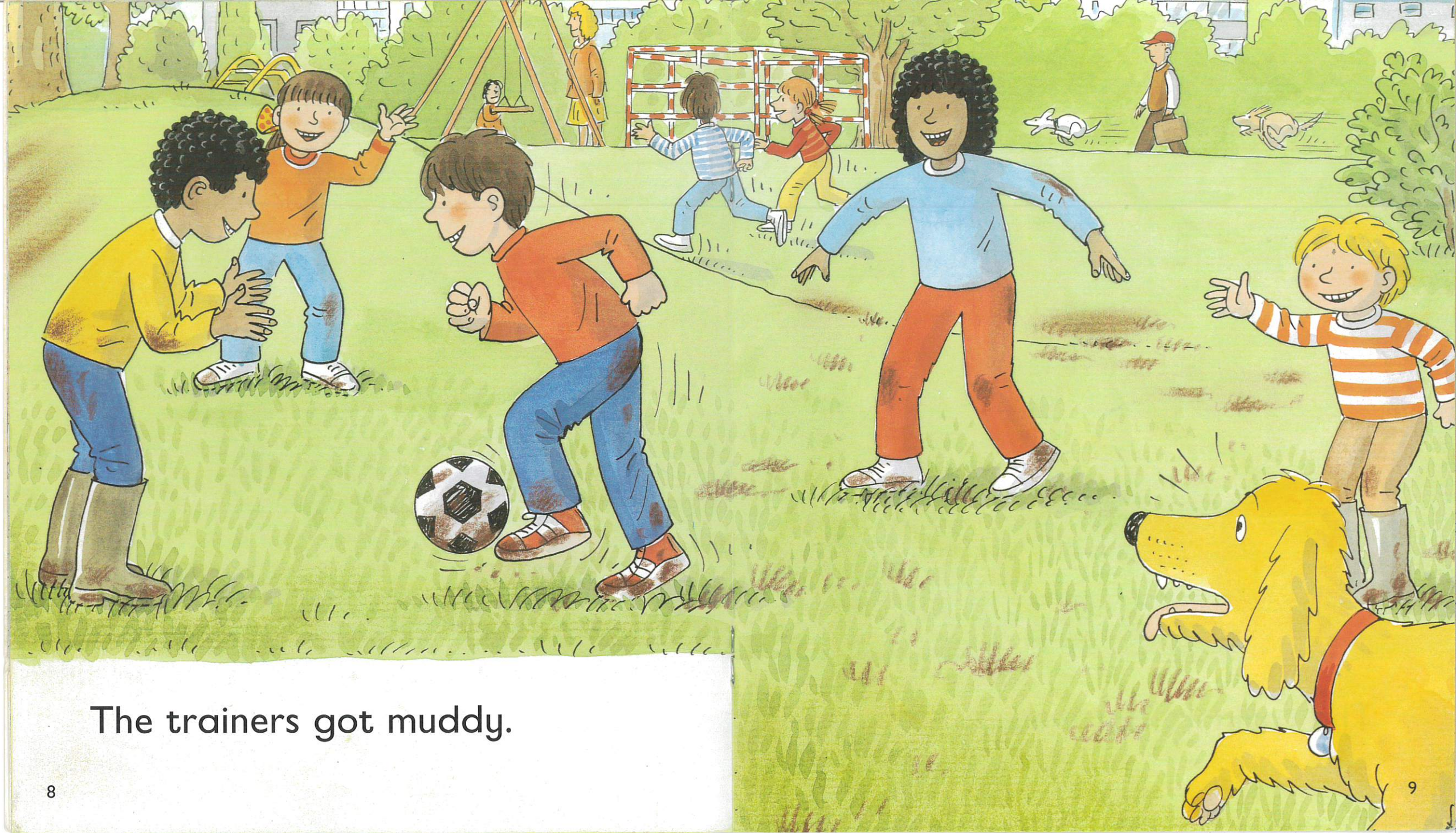


Chip wore the new trainers.

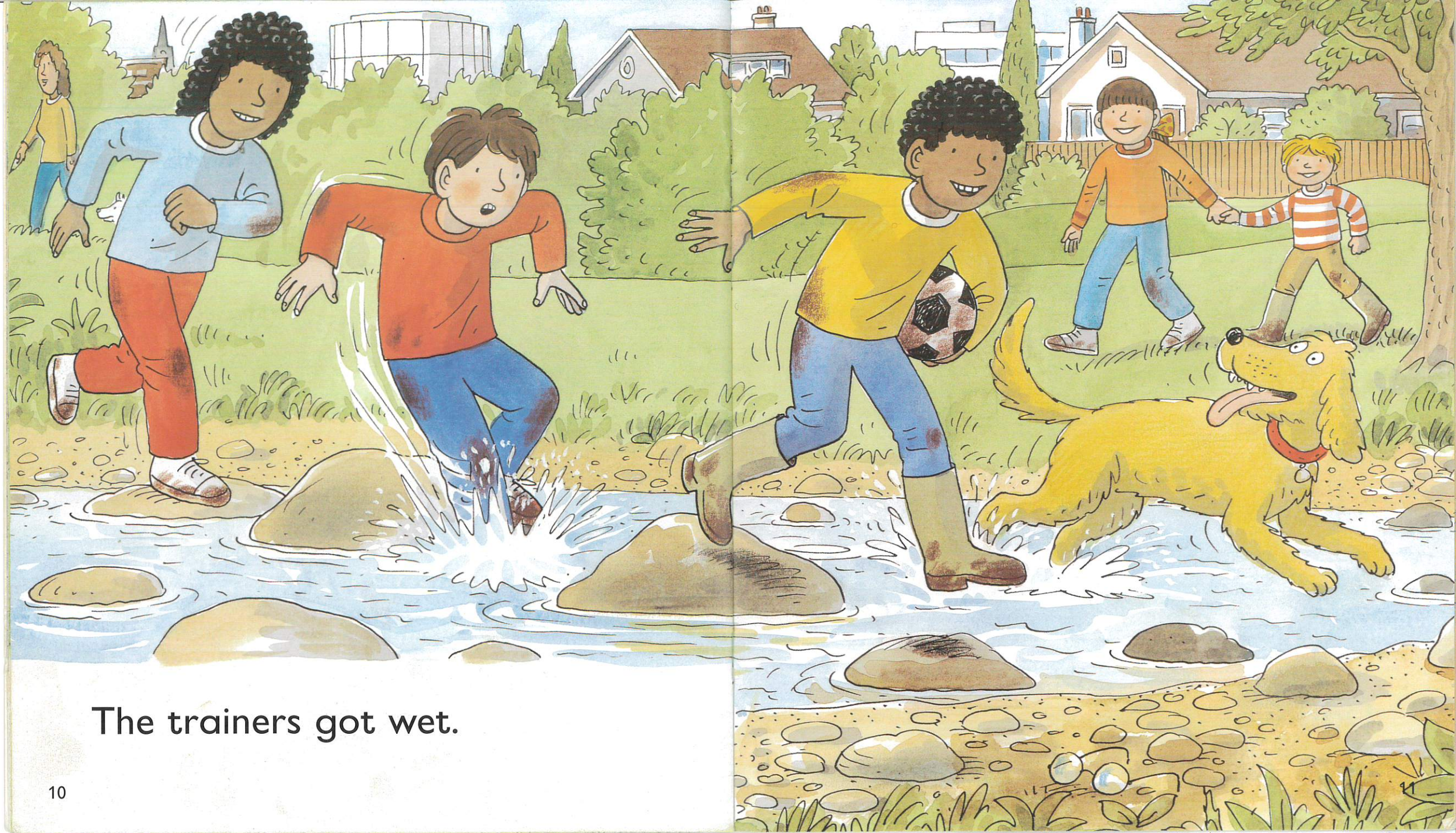




Chip went to play.
