Foundation Phase Arrival and Departure Procedures

We will continue to have staggered arrivals and departure times. Thank you for not arriving more than 5 minutes before your given time. This is to limited mixing on the yard. If you have children in more than one year group please arrive at the *earliest child's time*. We will arrange for you to collect both children at the same time.

Please note the *change of times* on the FP timetable. Things have run very smoothly and so we will try a ten minute stagger from next week Monday 8th March.

Thank you for continuing to wearing masks on the school site, for following the signs and staying 2m apart. We all want to avoid a further lockdown or having to close classrooms or the school. Thank you, too, for not arriving too early. However, I must remind some parents, that you must leave the school site as soon as you have collected your child. It is important if you have younger siblings with you that they stay by your side. We have worked very hard to ensure that children do not mix year group bubbles in school time. It was disheartening to see a number of children from different year groups playing on the yard together after school. Children must not do this. Children must not play on the equipment on the yard. We are staggering access to the equipment for the children from week to week to lower the risks of COVID cross-contamination. Please do not stay to have a chat with other parents. Also, the message from WG was clear. Even though children are returning to school, they should not be mixing outside of school, even with children in their class. Children really are good at telling us everything they do at home.
